Queens University of Charlotte to renovate Belk Chapel

Queens University of Charlotte plans to renovate the historic Belk Chapel in order to improve functionality. These improvements are projected to cost \$1,400,000. Belk Chapel is used by the Queens University community, and is also a popular wedding venue. According to the Queens University website, "Belk Chapel has been a special place on the Queens campus since it was built in 1950".

The additions include: a small reception room, men's and women's public restrooms, a classroom, and a room that will serve as both a meditation room and a bridal suite. The chapel will have a new façade that faces Radcliffe Avenue along with a circular driveway, which will be useful for wedding parties. A courtyard will be added between Belk Chapel and Rogers Science & Health Building which will serve as an entryway to main campus from the Harris Welcome Center.
